Introduction



Purpose Of Accreditation

- ...graduates of accredited programme satisfy minimum requirement for registration with BEM / IEM
- …ensures CQI is being practiced
- ...serves as a tool to benchmark programmes

Focus of EAC in Accreditation

- Outcome-based Engineering Education (OBE) Programme
- Programme Continual Quality Improvement (CQI)
- Ensuring the expected engineering education level is maintained

Critical Success Factors



- Management Commitment
- Well documented self-assessment report (with CQI)
- Significant Implementation of Outcome-based Education (OBE) Curriculum
- Ensure depth of knowledge appropriate
- Provision of appropriate facilities
- Well prepared staff & students
- Having the right stakeholders
- Having the appropriate human resources
- Financially sustainable

What is expected from USM Engineering Programme?



- Formulation and assessment of Programme Objectives and Outcomes with stakeholders (staff, students, alumni, industry) input
- Professional development of staff (OBE and assessment workshops)
- Staff clear on the appropriate depth of knowledge and able to demonstrate the achievement
- Staff implement CQI at all levels
- Conduct curriculum benchmarking
- Students involvement during implementation of programme

QA Check list



- Briefed Accompanying staff / guide
- Tidiness/ Neatness of facilities
- Documents / records availability
- Interview lists (staff, students, stakeholders)
- Meeting Rooms and associated facilities
- Transport
- Communication with all parties
- Visibility of policies
- Meals arrangement



DO\$

- Have simple lunch/teas in evaluation room
- Be formal
- Have the right persons / guides always available
- Provide name tags of those involved
- Provide signage
- Provide all documents/records in evaluation room
- Provide computer and printing facilities

DON'Ts

- Have extravagant lunch/teas in far away plush places
- Provide tokens for panels
- Waste time

Professionalism during the Visit day



- Short and concise briefing:
 - what is your niche?
 - what is new?
- Organised
- Punctual
- Courteous
- Not argumentative
- Well dressed
- Not over friendly

Visit day



- Opening Meeting
 - Led by EAC & followed by USM "SHORT" presentation
- Evaluation
 - Evidence: Interview, check documents and records, and observe
 - Note down proceedings (accompanying person)
- Closing Meeting
 - Clarification or correction of factual inaccuracies
 - No arguments (accompanying staff had noted possible nonconformances)
 - Do not ask for a solution

EAC's Accreditation signifies:



- Confidence that the programme is continually updated and satisfied the minimum standards of outcomes based engineering education
- A good practice is to identify the corrective actions and attend to those that can be immediately corrected
